How to Enter the Striking Against Breast Cancer (SABC) Mixed Doubles Tournament

- Watch the SABCMDT Facebook page for the announcement that entries have opened.
- **Note that this is the only way that entries will be accepted**
- Go to TournamentPay.com
 - Set up an account or Log In
 - Use all lowercase for your email address
 - In the menu bar, click on *Tournaments*, then *Search/Enter Upcoming Tournaments*
 - Choose Striking Against Breast Cancer Mixed Doubles Tournament
 - Fill in the entry for your team
 - **DO NOT LEAVE ANY FIELDS BLANK (you will get an error)**
 - Team/Bowler Information
 - Enter both names here (woman first)
 - Example: Jane Doe and John Doe
 - Team Line Up (Order: 1-Woman; 2-Man)
 - Full Name
 - PBA/PWBA players, please list the same name used when competing professionally
 - Hometown
 - PBA/PWBA players, please list the same city used when competing professionally
 - International players, please put your city here even though we will only use your country – this field has to be filled in
 - State
 - PBA/PWBA players, please list the same state or country used when competing professionally
 - International players, this is where you will list your country
 - Email
 - One email for each bowler (you cannot use the same email address for both bowlers)
 - Phone
 - One phone for each bowler
 - Partner is TBD:
 - Add TBD for the name and hometown.
 - Use your phone and a secondary email address (you cannot use the same email address for your TBD bowler)
 - Note that you are responsible for full team fees
 - Submit
 - You will receive a notification that your entry was submitted
 - Continue to the next page for instructions on "How & When to Pay for Your SABCMDT Entry"

How & When to Pay for Your SABCMDT Entry

- Once the team has been added to the tournament roster, each member of the team will receive an email that their entry status has been approved and it is time to pay the entry fee
 - NOTE: Full team fees must be paid via the online tournament site within 72 hours (3 days) of notification**
 - Failure to pay within the specified timeframe will result in team moving to wait list
 - When you receive the email notification, return to [TournamentPay.com](#)
 - Note: Do NOT set up a new entry, follow instructions below**
 - In the menu bar, click on *Tournaments*, then *Tournaments I Entered*
 - Click *View*, then click *Pay*
 - If you do not see your team, then there's an issue with the email address you logged in with versus the email address on your entry; please send an email to StrikingAgainstBreastCancer@gmail.com with the subject line "Cannot locate team entry"
 - Select the bowler name(s) then click on *Make Payment*
 - Note that the entry fees can be paid individually or together, but both must be paid within the 72-hour timeframe
 - You will receive a notification that payment was successful as well as an email with the receipt attached.

FAQs

Q. I am still looking for a partner, but I know that the tournament fills up quickly...what should I do?

A. You are welcome to submit an entry. For the TBD partner information, please see the TBD directions above. You will be responsible for paying for the full team fees. Once you find a partner, send an email, copying your partner, to StrikingAgainstBreastCancer@gmail.com with the subject line "2026 SABC Tournament Partner Update". In the email, let us know your partner name, hometown, email address and phone. (For PBA/PWBA players, please list the same name, hometown and state/country as used when competing professionally.) Your partner will pay you for their portion of the team entry fee.

Q. I have a partner change, what should I do?

A. For a partner change, send an email, copying your previous partner and your new partner (please copy both), to StrikingAgainstBreastCancer@gmail.com with the subject line "2026 SABC Tournament Partner Change". In the email, let us know your new partner name, hometown, email address and phone. (For PBA/PWBA players, please list the same name, hometown and state/country as used when competing professionally.) If your previous partner paid for their own entry, please have your new partner send them their entry fee. Venmo, Zelle, etc. are wonderful tools to do this. We thank you for making this change.

Q. My team needs to withdraw, what should we do?

A. Please send an email, copying your partner, to StrikingAgainstBreastCancer@gmail.com with the subject line "2026 SABC Tournament Withdrawal". In the email, let us know how the entry fee(s) were paid (one person paid for the team or each paid their own portion), along with name(s) and address(es) so that we can send the refund check(s).

Q. I have a question that has not been answered here, what should I do?
